PROMOTION: Flatbed Field Goal Challenge

DATES: Entries will be accepted from Thursday, September 4, 2025 – Saturday, November 1, 2025.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE: No purchase necessary to register. You must be at least 18 years old to enter, a Michigan resident and able to provide valid photo identification upon participating. Enter to participate at each Wayne State University (WSU) home football game at a TBD location.

PARTICIPANT SELECTION, LOGISTICS AND KICKING RULES: Each contestant will be selected by random drawing of all entries submitted for each home football game. Contestants must be present in order to participate. There will be one randomly chosen contestant per Wayne State University (“WSU”) home football game. Contestants will be chosen by a representative of WSU or the Association and will be contacted via phone or text at each home football game after the first quarter. Each contestant must kick or punt a standard NCAA football of regulation size and weight into the bed of a Chevrolet Silverado from a distance of 35 yards. Each contestant will be allowed a maximum of one (1) kick attempt. No practice or warm-up kicks may be made under any circumstances. The football must enter the Silverado truck bed on the fly and come to rest inside of the truck bed to be considered a winning attempt. The ball may not bounce into or out of the truck bed. A kicked ball that bounces, deflects, or otherwise come into contact with any object, person, or surface prior to entering the truck bed is automatically disqualified. A kicked ball that makes initial contact with the inside surface of the truck bed and subsequently bounces out of the truck bed and onto any other surface or portion of the truck is not eligible to be considered a winning kick. Once the ball makes contact with any object, person, or surface, the ball will not constitute a winning kick under any circumstances. When kicking the ball, the football must be held by an individual from WSU on the ground or a simulated holding device (which is approved by the Association or a WSU representative). No tees of any sort may be used. No aid of any kind may be given to the contestant participating in these events. Nothing may be done to the football, Silverado, contestant’s footwear or playing surface that would enhance the contestants’ chances of successfully completing the kick. Once selected as a contestant, he or she may not re-select anyone else to kick for him or her.

GRAND PRIZE: \$5000.00 (less applicable federal and state taxes which may be no less than 25%) if the kick is successful. If the kick does not land in and stay in the Chevrolet Silverado truck bed the contestant will receive a \$100 Visa Gift Card just for participating.

GENERAL CONTEST RULES

- 1. Eligibility and Limitations.** Entrants and winners must be at least 18-years old, and a Michigan resident. Void outside Michigan and where prohibited. Previous winners, employees of the members of the Association, its advertising agencies, and members of the immediate family of any such persons are not eligible to participate and win. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, cohabitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related. Each entrant must show proper identification.

No purchase is necessary to be eligible to win. Purchase of any product or service from a Metro Detroit Chevrolet Dealer will not increase your chance to win. Limit one (1) entry per person. Multiple entries received from one person after the first entry received will be void.

- 2. Publicity and Marketing.** By participating, all entrants, participants, and winners grant the Metro Detroit Chevrolet Dealers Local Marketing Association ("Association") exclusive permission to use their names, location, characters, photographs, voices, and likenesses for promotional purposes including but not limited to social media and electronic newsletters, and in connection with promotion of this and other contests and waive any claims to royalty, right, or remuneration for such use. You also grant permission to the Association to contact you from time to time, for market research purposes or to provide promotional messages (in the form of mail or email) about services and specials offered by the Association or its member dealerships.
- 3. Odds of Winning.** Odds of winning are based on the number of entries received.
- 4. Prize Release.** By participating, each entrant, participant, and winner waives and releases any and all claims of liability against WSU and the Association, its members and agents, for any loss, which may occur from the conduct of, or participation in, the contest, or from the use of any prize.
- 5. Taxes.** Any valuation of the prize awarded is based on available information provided to the Association and the value of any prize awarded to a winner will be reported for tax purposes as required by law. Winner must provide all reasonable information requested by the Association including, but not limited to name, address, email address, driver's license or state identification number, telephone number and social security number. The winner is responsible for payment of all federal, state, and local income taxes applicable on the prize awarded based on its' value and will pay to the Association for transmission to the IRS 25% of the value of the grand prize at the time it is claimed. Failure to take possession of the prize and to make the federal tax payment within fourteen (14) days

will result in forfeiting the grand prize. The Association will deduct \$1,250.00 for taxes and the Grand Prize Winner will receive a check for \$3,750.00 unless greater amounts are required to be deducted by applicable law.

6. **No Substitution.** The prize cannot be substituted for any other items by the winner. The winner cannot assign or transfer the prize.
7. **Applicable Laws.** This contest is subject to all applicable laws and regulations. The Association is not responsible for typographical or other errors in the printing, offering or administration of the contest or in the announcement of the prize.
8. **Participation Release.** By entering, each entrant represents they are eligible and agree to be bound by these rules and the decisions of the Association in all matters including, without limitation, eligibility of contestants. Each entrant, participant, and winner release both Wayne State University, and the Association, its directors, officers, advertising representatives and agents from any and all liability for any injuries, losses or damages of any kind resulting from entrant's entry into this contest or from acceptance, possession or use of the prize and waives any such claims. If for any reason a potential contestant and winner is ineligible, unable or unwilling to take possession of the prize, then the potential contestant/winner will be disqualified and forfeit the prize, and an alternate contestant will be selected by the Association in its sole discretion at random from among all remaining entries. In such event, the disqualified potential contestant/winner will not be awarded any prize.

THE ASSOCIATION WILL RESOLVE ANY DISPUTES, CONFLICTING CLAIMS OR AMBIGUITIES CONCERNING THE RULES AND ITS DECISION CONCERNING SUCH DISPUTES SHALL BE FINAL. Failure to explicitly conform to all terms and conditions outlined herein will result in a claim denial.
11. **Prize and Location.** Unless otherwise stated, each entrant will provide his or her zip code and/or preferred Metro Detroit Chevy Dealership upon entering this contest. Unless otherwise stated, all winners will take possession of their prize at the Chevrolet dealership that they identified when they entered the contest. Each winner will be required to appear at that Chevrolet dealership to complete paperwork, take photos, and receive their prize.
